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Use of Contrast – (Gadolinium)

Gadolinium is a clear fluid which is prescribed by a specialist Radiologist and administered intravenously; (usually via an arm vein), under supervision during an MRI examination. It provides improved diagnostic accuracy and information; the use of contrast does not imply serious disease and is often used to rule out disease. The risk of any serious reaction to MR contrast is extremely low. Most patients experience no effects while a few notice a transient metallic taste. Rare reports of skin and joint problems in patients who have received MR contrast agents are largely confined to patients who have serious kidney or liver disease and who have had multiple injections. Our Radiologist will not prescribe contrast if you are in a high risk category. Data on the safety on contrast use in pregnancy has not been established. **Contrast will not be administered to you if you are pregnant.**
